Mounting Instructions - 'Clip-it'

- Choose any smooth surface with enough room to mount this brochure and the 'Clip-it' supplied in the immediate area of your ultrasonic cleaner.
- 2. Clean the area with methylated spirits and then wipe with a clean dry cloth.
- 3. Peel the backing paper from the 'Clip-it' making sure not to touch the adhesive.
- 4. Press 'Clip-it' firmly into vertical position and hold for 30 seconds, then leave for 24 hours before using.
- 5. Mount this brochure with 'Directions for Use' visible.

<u>WARNING</u> Do not use 'Clip-it' on wallpaper, porous or rough surfaces, or on a surface where the temperature exceeds 60°C.

Testing must be carried out in accordance with the following instructions and the Ultrasonic Cleaner Manufacturer's Directions for use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Commence with a clean, empty ultrasonic machine.
- 2. Fill with water to the recommended level.
- 3. Perform 'Degassing' procedure as per manufacturers instuctions.
- 4. Rub the surface of the disc with the special test pencil provided.
- 5. Immerse the disk in the centre of the ultrasonic cleaning tank on the rack provided by the manufacturer.
- 6. Set the time for 3 minutes and start the ultrasonic machine.

WARNING

Do not touch when ultrasonic machine is operating.

7. When cycle is complete, remove ULTRASONITEST.

NOTE

The ultrasonic cleaner should completely remove the pencil marks within 3 minutes.

- 8. Record results on Results Sheet.
- 9. Check disk for surface integrity, if smooth, replace the disk (up to 60 uses per disk).
- 10. Return disk, test pencil and result sheet to 'Clip-it' immediately after use.
